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Online Safety

Tuesday 6th February is Safer Internet Day, which is the UK's biggest celebration of online safety. To prepare our children for some of the online safety activities going on in school next week, our Talk Assemblies this week focussed upon the differences between being online and offline. All children identified the uses of being online and the advantages the internet can bring to our lives. We also discussed the importance of being offline, including the benefits of socialising with people. We all agreed on some important rules for keeping safe online, including the need to report to a trusted adult if online behaviour makes you feel upset, confused or worried.
